# **Uniting Care - Prison Ministry**

Rev Wendy McHugh, Jessie Saunders, Linda Hansen

- 40-50 volunteers cover 15 prisons.
- Provide Sunday services, art therapy, parcels of necessities post release
- High levels of homelessness after prison release, often leads to reoffending and incarceration to have roof over their head
- High ATSI incarceration rate
- There is a genuine openness to the word of God
- Needs more chaplains, working towards 1 chaplain for every 300 inmates
- New 1500 bed prison being built in the Lockyer Valley
- prayer from congregations welcome and congregations can provide places of inclusion for released prisoners
