Some other highlights from this meeting were:

- Changes to Presbytery Standing Committee and Pastoral Relations Committee Presbytery Standing Committee we farewelled Mrs Sharon Baker (Member), Rev Marius Kruger (Member) and Rev Adam Tipple (Chair); extended the terms of Mrs Kath Warner (Member) and Ms Allison Kahler (Secretary), and welcomed Rev John Case (Chair) and Rev Dylan Miegel (Member); Mrs Jenny Noble (Treasurer continues her term until 2026.
